# Residential Tax Credit Certificate TAX YEAR 2018



As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, tax incentives for homeowners and businesses are available to help encourage the use of renewable energy technologies like geothermal heat pumps. Tax incentives for ENERGY STAR® qualified residential geothermal heat pumps are available until December 31, 2021.

The law offers a tax credit of 30% of the total investment for all ENERGY STAR qualified residential geothermal heat pump installations until December 31, 2019. In 2020 the law will offer a tax credit of 26%, and then in 2021 it will drop to 22%. To qualify for the rebate, the system must meet or exceed ENERGY STAR requirements and be installed after January 1, 2009 (After December 01, 2009 for water-to-water units).
